#### **Ukrainian Crisis Appeal**

In partnership with The International Aid Trust and St Laurence's, SVP Chorley Buddies have agreed to try to co-ordinate a response from the Catholic Community in Chorley. We are accepting donations of the following items: clothing, footwear, bedding, toiletries, dried food (with at least 1 year's date), sleeping bags and cooking pots and pans.

From w/c Monday 7<sup>th</sup> March, SVP Chorley Buddies will be available to collect any donations from our churches to take them to St Laurence's for storage and distribution by International Aid Trust to families in Ukraine. Donations can be left at the back of our churches and we will pass them on.

They are hoping to collect paracetamol, ibuprofen, Calpol, toothpaste and brushes, hygiene items for ladies, nappies, dried milk for babies, nappy rash creams.

Fr Marsden at St Mary's Church, Chorley, is accepting financial donations which are going directly to Bishop Komar. His diocese has been flooded with wounded soldiers. Donated monies are buying antibiotics, bandages, syringes and pain relief medications.


We pray for the world that in this moment of crisis, we may reach out in solidarity to our brothers and sisters in need.
