Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord 2nd April 2023



Today marks the beginning of the "Holy Week". Our Masses this weekend end in silence and in anticipation of the solemn celebrations to come.

The Church teaches that this

week is for the year what each Sunday is for the week – a time of prayer and attentiveness that should be different for our normal routines. Please make time to attend our services during the Holy Triduum if you can.

Our Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at St Chad's Church and our Easter Vigil of the Resurrection will be celebrated at St. Bede's Church. *These celebrations are for all the members of both our parishes.* As once again we live through the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus, we return to the source of grace and joy that is with us through the year. Let's pray that this Holy Week will be a moment of renewal for ourselves and for our parish community and that our gratitude for God's merciful love will be deepened.

The distribution of the Precious Blood will be restored, for those who wish to receive from the chalice, from the Mass of the Lord's Supper on 6th April.

We have been asked to remind our parishioners that it is **not permitted** in the Catholic Church in



England and Wales to receive the Precious Blood by "intinction", that is by dipping the Host into the chalice.

We have lost a few of our Special Ministers of Holy Communion over the past few years so the chalice might not be offered at every Mass yet. *If you attend Mass each week in our parishes and would like to volunteer as a Special Minister of Holy Communion please talk to Fr Mark.* This role requires a DBS check and volunteers are asked to attend a meeting for training before they are commissioned to exercise their ministry at celebrations of the Eucharist.

It would be good to have different volunteers for reading at Mass and for helping with the distribution of Holy Communion. If you would like to volunteer to read at Mass please let us know. A few new voices would be very welcome. We are also always happy to welcome new helpers for cleaning our Churches and arranging flowers. Our church cleaners meet on Wednesday mornings at St Chad's and on Thursday mornings at St Bede's.

Easter Egg Hunt - Weather permitting!

After our Easter Morning Masses we hope to offer to the children of our parish an Easter Egg Hunt around the grounds of our churches. Children must be accompanied by an adult as they make their way around. We could do with a couple more helpers at St Chad's. If you are able to help please let Fr Mark know. Thank you.


