Learning about our Catholic Faith

We will be starting a group in the New Year at St Bede's for anyone who would like to know more about becoming a Catholic, getting Confirmed as an adult, or coming back to Mass after some time away. Please talk to Fr Mark or Sr Dorothy if you are interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith.

Our First Holy Communion preparation will begin in February for children in Year 4 and above. If your child does not attend St Bede's or St Chad's Primary Schools and you would like them to make their First Holy Communion this year, please let us **know** and we can let you know when the classes will begin.

If anyone is interested in joining our team of catechists at St Chad's please talk to Fr Mark who can let you know what it involves.

Donations of warm clothing, toiletries and non-perishable food can be left at the back of our churches. We support the Bamber-Bridge foodbank, Chorley Help the Homeless and the Preston Metanoia Project.

St Bede's St Vincent de Paul Group is now up and running again.

The group exists to support those disadvantaged in our community. They raise funds through collections after Masses and other events. Through the "Twinnage" scheme they also support the work of an SVP group in a poorer part of the world. The more members we have the more people we will be able to support. Voluntary collections for the SVP will be taken after weekend Masses on two Sundays each month at St Bede's. Thank you for your support.
