CAFOD SUDAN EMERGENCY APPEAL. RETIRING COLLECTION AFTER ALL MASSES THIS WEEKEND.

The conflict in Sudan has created a massive crisis across the region: 25 million people are in need of humanitarian aid and protection, more than 10 million have been displaced from their homes, and almost 15,000 people have lost their lives. Sadly, it is the most vulnerable, especially people with disabilities, who are the hardest hit. Our teams in Chad and Egypt are working hard to support disabled and vulnerable people, by providing physical rehabilitation services, mental health support and access to humanitarian aid. Without this vital support, the huge needs in these areas are barely covered, if at all. We are also launching activities inside Sudan with a partner organisation and working to strengthen local health systems and build the capacity of local NGOs to respond.

Can you help?

Over the past few years some of our volunteers have had to step down from their service in our parishes. We are always looking for more people to share their time and talents in God's service. We need readers, Little Church helpers, cleaners, people to help look after the church grounds and gardens, help with organising parish events, serving tea and coffee after Sunday Mass, volunteers for our parish social committees etc. It would be good to have a bit more help with our music in Church too - musicians and singers who can help us broaden our repertoire at Mass. Guitarists and organists who can help out now and again would be very welcome. If you would like to get involved, please have a chat with Fr Mark who would be very happy to hear from you.

Next Sunday, 12th May, the Church keeps World Communications Day. There will be a retiring collection at all Masses to support the Church's work of sharing the Gospel through all the different forms of communication that people use today.

As part of our thanksgiving for 200 years of St Bede's Parish Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be held at St Bede's Church next month. It will begin with Mass at 7pm on Wednesday 22nd May and conclude with a Holy Hour of Prayer and Thanksgiving at 7pm on Friday 24th May.
