Both parishes will have a Polling Station in their Parish Centres for the General Election on the 4thJuly. All the activities which usually occur on that day will not take place.

St Bede's Prayer Group will meet on Monday in St Bede's Presbytery at 1pm – 2.30pm. Everyone is very welcome to come along.





Tuesday, 30th July 10am – 4pm Retreat Day. As part of the celebrations for the Bicentenary of St Bede's Parish we have booked a retreat day at Hyning Hall Monastery, Warton near Carnforth. There will be a talk from one of the sisters, Mass and Holy Hour and we will join the community for Midday prayer in the chapel. There will be plenty of time to spend in the extensive gardens. The sisters have space for 30 day guests. To keep costs down we are asking people to bring a packed lunch and to make their own way there. We are hoping that people

might offer a lift to anyone who can't get there by car. It's a 35 mile, 40 minute drive – 7 minutes off the M6 Carnforth exit. There are envelopes at the back of church to book your place. We ask for £10 from each participant if you can manage that. Speak to Fr Mark if you can't. If the event is oversubscribed, we will arrange for a second day of retreat so everyone can get a chance to take part.

St Chad's Reading Group The next meeting of the reading group is on **Monday 1**st **July** from 2pm to 4pm in **St. Chad's Parish Centre**. Books are provided from the County Library service and are available to borrow at each meeting. New members are very welcome.

Fr Mark recently did some training on being a more "welcoming church", looking particularly at different needs people might have due to health conditions or living with a physical or learning disability. Sight loss, hearing difficulties, seating needs, level access to our buildings etc. might make it more difficult for people to join fully in the life of our parish. If you, or someone you know, has a particular need or difficulty in church please let us know. We would be very happy to do whatever we can to help you. Some people have said that it isn't always easy to hear what is being said at Mass. We have asked a sound company to come and look at our amplification systems. There is a Loop System in both our churches for people who use a hearing aid. We rely on people who use it to let us know when it isn't working. Thank you.
