This Sunday, 21st July, there will be a retiring collection at all Masses for **Priests in retirement.** Our retired priests responded to the call to be priests, they devoted their lives to serving God and God's people. Whilst they 'retire' at the age of 75, they are still priests for life. Many continue in ministry leading active lives – celebrating Mass, serving as chaplains, counselling people in need, supporting parish life and praying for us all. The priests' retirement fund, ensures that our retired priests enjoy a dignified retirement. It supports independent living, providing them with a suitable home alongside other services. Above all, it makes sure that their social and healthcare needs are met. Our priests rely on this support after devoting their lives to the Church's mission and bringing people closer to Christ. Over the next ten years, approximately one third of our diocesan priests will reach retirement age, and the cost of care will rise significantly as a result of this. With your help, we can continue to offer our gratitude and support to our retired priests. Please remember our sick and retired priests in your prayers.



Tuesday, 30th July 10am – 4pm Retreat Day at Hyning Hall Monastery, Warton near Carnforth. There will be a talk from one of the sisters, Mass and Holy Hour and we will join the community for Midday prayer in the chapel.

There will be plenty of time to spend in the extensive gardens. The sisters have space for 30 day guests. To

keep costs down we are asking people to bring a packed lunch and to make their own way there. Lifts are available to anyone who can't get there by car. It's a 35 mile, 40 minute drive – 7 minutes off the M6 Carnforth

Tea and coffee will be served in St. Chad's Parish Centre **this Sunday after the 9.15am Mass**. Everyone is warmly invited to come along.

Some people have said that it isn't always easy to hear what is being said at Mass. We have asked a sound company to come and look at our amplification systems. There is a Loop System in both our churches for people who use a hearing aid. We rely on people who use it to let us know when it isn't working. Thank you.

If you are part of our parish Gift Aid Scheme, we can claim back the Gift Aid on your donation if you write your Gift Aid envelope number on the Mass Intention request. Thank you.
