Friday 1st November is the Feast of All Saints. It is a Holy Day of Obligation when we are asked to attend Mass. There will be a Vigil Mass on Thursday 31st October at 7pm. Masses on All Saints Day will be 9.15am at St Chad's and 11am at St Bede's. All the children from St Bede's School will be attending Mass you are asked to fill up from the back rows when you arrive in church. Thank you. On Saturday 2nd November there will be an extra Mass at 10am at St Chad's for the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day)

November – Month of the Holy Souls. During the month of November we especially remember in prayer those who have died. Masses will be offered for the names on our November List. If you would like anyone who has died to be remembered in these Masses please write their names on a piece of paper and put them in an envelope. A donation for the parish may also be included. Hand them in through the door of either presbytery or into the sacristy. Thank you.

Mass of Remembrance. Each November we hold a Mass in memory of those who have had their funeral through the parish over the past year and all those named on our November List. We invite the families and friends of those who have had their funeral through the parish over the past year to attend and light a candle during the Mass and then all our parishioners are invited to light a candle in memory of their own loved ones who have died. Our Masses this year will be on Thursday 7th November at St Chad's and on Friday 8th November at St Bede's. Both will start at 7pm and there will be a chance to gather over a cup of tea afterwards.

Little Church – Thank you to our team of helpers who work with our younger parishioners at Masses on Sunday. We are very grateful for your help. We really need a few more people who are willing to make up the numbers of helpers who have a DBS check.
