Mass of Remembrance. Each November we hold a Mass in memory of those who have had their funeral through the parish over the past year and all those named on our November List. We invite the families and friends of those who have had their funeral through the parish over the past year to attend and light a candle during the Mass and then all our parishioners are invited to light a candle in memory of their own loved ones who have died. Our Masses this year will be on **Thursday 7th November at St Chad's** and on **Friday 8th November at St Bede's**. Both will start at 7pm and there will be a chance to gather over a cup of tea afterwards.
