We will meet at St Joseph's Church, Brindle for a 1.30pm departure, returning for Mass at 4.30pm, followed by the opportunity to view items associated with St Edmund and refreshments in the parish room. The walk is approximately 5 miles and involves some cross-country sections which can be boggy after rainfall. En route there will be an opportunity to visit the Mass Room at Arrowsmith House where St Edmund celebrated his final Mass in 1628, before being captured on Brindle Moss, and to watch a short film about his life. All welcome.

We have been asked to print the following statement by Fr Simon Henry regarding the **Church of St Catherine Labouré**, **Farrington**.

A fuller version of this statement is available at the back of church. "Last year the parish of St Catherine Labouré at Farrington and the parish of St Mary at Euxton were merged to become one parish with two churches. In the months since then we have reflected and held consultations which were used to assist Archbishop John in his decisions for our parish. Through those, it became obvious that we simply do not need and cannot sustain two physical sites for the parish. The result is that the Archbishop has signed the decree which will see St Catherine's Church "taken out of use for public worship" - the formal way of saying that the physical church will close.

Archbishop John will celebrate a final Mass of Thanksgiving and celebration of the life of the church at 7pm on Friday 5th September 2025. Due to the small size of the church, this will need to be a ticketed event to sit in the church but doors open into our hall to cater for anyone that might arrive. A Reception in a marquee in the grounds will follow. Please do pray for us through the intercession of Our Blessed Lady and St Catherine to guide us in our new path.
