Holy Week is the most important week of the Christian year.

Just as Sunday is the heart of every week, Holy Week is the heart of the entire liturgical year — the moment when we walk with Christ through his Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

Everything in the Church’s life flows from these days.


Today, Palm Sunday, we remember with gratitude the love shown by Our Lord as he enters Jerusalem to give his life for us.



On **Holy Thursday** night we enter the Sacred Triduum by remembering the Last Supper, where Jesus washes the feet of his disciples and gives us the great gift of the Eucharist. We receive the new commandment to love one another in humble service in imitation of him. After Mass, the Blessed Sacrament is taken to the Altar of

Repose, inviting us to keep watch with the Lord in Gethsemane.

Good Friday is a day of fasting, silence, and deep reverence. We listen to the proclamation of the Passion of the Lord. We venerate the Cross on which he died to set us free, and we solemnly pray for the Church and for the world. There is no Mass today; instead, we receive Holy Communion consecrated the night before at the Mass of the Last Supper.



On **Holy Saturday** the Church waits at the tomb in quiet hope. After nightfall, the Easter Vigil begins with the new fire and the proclamation of Christ’s victory. We hear the great story of salvation, celebrate the sacraments of initiation for new members of our Church, and rejoice as the light of the Resurrection breaks into the darkness.

On **Easter Sunday** the Church across the world gathers to rejoice in the light of the resurrection and the new life Christ has won for us.

Tea and coffee will be served in **St. Chad's Parish Centre** after the **9.15am Mass** and in **St. Bede's Parish Hall** after the **11am Mass** on **Sunday 5th April**. Everyone is warmly invited to come along.



Following the 9.15am Mass at St Chad's and the 11am Mass at

St Bede's on Sunday 5th April our Little Church teams have organised an **Easter Egg Hunt** around the grounds of our churches which all our

children are invited to join but they must be accompanied by an adult.


